DARKNETS

Darknets can be described as the hidden, anonymous underbelly of the searchable web—stuff that isn't discoverable by the major search engines. It isn't recommended that readers delve into this often nefarious web activity, but it's worth knowing that it's out there.

ComputerEdge® Online publisher Jack Dunning has written a comprehensive article on "software for enabling online anonymity and censorship resistance." **Tor** (previously an acronym for **The Onion Router**) is free and open source software for Windows, Mac, Linux/Unix, and Android. Developed by the U.S. Naval Research Laboratory, Tor network is one of the best known and most used darknets. The development, uses and governments/people/media that use Tor makes an interesting read.

In his 2/21/14 issue of ComputerEdge®, Dunning writes that media companies have set up hidden Tor sites for people to leak sensitive government of company activities and is likely the method Edward Snowden used for leaking NSA's classified documents. The notorious WikiLeaks is a well-known user of Tor.

The question is: "How does someone reach out from inside a despotic regime to like-minded people both in that country and elsewhere in the world without opening up oneself to serious personal danger? Enter Darknets."

Darknets are Internet worlds unknown by most people. They don't show up in the usual Web browsers and Google does not index their hidden sites. They are where worlds can congregate in a secret environment away from prying eyes—whether for promoting dissident movements or illicit activity <http://webservice.computoredge.com/online.mvc>

- Tor prevents people from learning your location or browsing habits.
- Tor is for web browsers, instant messaging clients, and more.
- Tor is free and open source for Windows, Mac, Linux/Unix, and Android

Comment by user: On first use there is no obvious way to stop a recording. No menu to stop recording and no BIG BUTTON to stop. I had to kill the process on my mac to stop it. On second/third use I saw a message to use a shortcut key. It flashed so fast I had to do it few times to pick up on the (3) keys I am supposed to use. Once I had them, they did not work!

To be fair, I did not realize *I needed to include the "Shift" in my shortcut key sequence.* After that, it seemed to deliver on its promise. I am increasing the stars now that I have had more time with it.

Note to Mavericks Users:

Looks as though Mavericks 10.9 has changed the behavior for adding application/document shortcuts to the Finder toolbar.

Where before you could simply drag any icon up to the Finder toolbar and hold it there for a second to add it, you now need to first hold down Option +Command and then start dragging the desired icon to the toolbar.

You can still remove the icons the same way as before: holding down Command, dragging the icon away from the toolbar and then releasing.

REALLY FAST INTERNET SPEEDS FROM GOOGLE USING GOOGLE FIBER

Over the last few years, gigabit Internet has moved from idea to reality, with dozens of communities working hard to build networks with speeds up to 100 times faster than what most of us live with today—from Google Fiber.

Jack Dunning of *ComputerEdge*[®] *online* has written a comprehensive summary of the complexities of providing fast internet services—the costs, political and governmental rules and regulations, and profits. To provide such services is an incredibly complicated, expensive and time-consuming process. Only three markets in the U.S. currently have access to this ultra-fast internet provided by Google Fiber: Provo, Kansas City and Austin. One Kansas City suburb delayed the political process too long and Google Fiber stopped negotiations. The *Kansas City Star* reporter wrote:

- **Google's patience with local regulations has limits**
- **Google Fiber is building only in neighborhoods where demand was strong enough to justify the expense**

It looks like it will be decades before Google Fiber can have an impact on most of the nation. The impediments to installing infrastructure (both physical and political) make progress slow.

What will be needed in the next decade is the one gigabit connection, but the cable companies seem to have little interest in doing the work of laying fiber

optic cable. It's easier to work out deals with Netflix and other Internet streaming services to squeeze more cash out of the current geographically monopolistic system.

Eventually, the dinosaurs die out. The current dinosaur is the cable industry. Enter Google Fiber.
