To summarize both reviews:

Pros: beautiful, great screen, interesting Touch Bar, Touch ID, massive trackpad, thin and relatively light, USB-C.

Cons: short battery life, no USB-A ports, no ethernet, no native display ports, no upgrading after purchase, very expensive.

And from *MacWorld* Senior Editor Roman Loyola:

"If you're planning to buy a new MacBook Pro, make sure you set aside a considerable amount of cash for the adapters you need. Apple doesn't include any in the box, except for a power adapter." Read his review at:

And, last but not least, there is no more "bong" chime on the MacBook Pro. There is no "on" button either. When you open the new MBP, that turns it on. One explanation

for the removal of the iconic sound is that many MBP users take them to meetings, classes, etc., and to eliminate the distraction of another MCP being opened by an attendee, Apple removed the start up "bong" sound.



USEFUL TIPS

Whenever you need an accent mark (or related foreign character), just hold down the appropriate letter, and a list of relevant options will pop up.





Make use of Apple's QuickTime Player. If you need to record whatever audio or video is playing

on your screen, for instance, you don't need to download any third-party software.



Reference points:

A 1140 Independence Street – 2nd house north of 11th on east side of street

B 6th and Kipling

P Parking across street from Cheryl's home

Parking:

Cheryl's semi-circular driveway ~ 5 cars.

Across street to the south on Independence are two driveways for ~ 4 cars each.

Parking on street in front of Cheryl's house. Watch for ditch between street and the house.

No street lights here, so bring a flashlight!

Easy ways to get to Cheryl's house:

- 1140 Independence Street is east of Kipling between Colfax Avenue and 6th Avenue. Drive to 10th Street or 11th Street and turn east to Independence. Turn left on Independence.
- From Colfax Avenue east of Kipling, turn south on Independence Street and drive across the light-rail tracks. House will be on east side in 1100 block.
