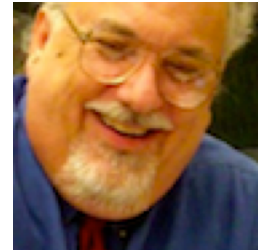

iOS AUTOCORRECT FIX

or as Jeff Gamet of *The MacObserver* says, "How to Convince Ducking Auto-correct You Don't Mean Duck."

To make a Quick Tip "memorable," Jeff Gamet explains how to insure the sometimes indomitable autocorrect on our iOS devices doesn't continue to change the spelling to something your DON'T WANT. This is

memorable, so bear with Jeff in his explanation on how to fix it. You will remember it!

iOS sees names in your Contacts as legit spellings. If you enter names in Contacts before you write your text, they'll stay just as you type them. A comment made about this fix says it also works with Siri. Put the correct spelling in Contacts and Siri will recognize them too. Great article, Jeff!

John Martello of *The MacObserver* explains the reason to upgrade to the latest operating system for your Mac: **Security**

New to the Mac are the services of Siri. The voice activated search "personal assistant" is now available for the Mac, not just the iOS devices. Additionally, you can drag and drop Siri's search results from the Notifications pane into other apps for sharing or accessing at a later date.

Things that you can ask Siri include:

- Tell me what movies are playing today
- Read my latest email
- Text John 'See you soon smiley exclamation point'
- Find a table for four tonight
- Find me books by C.S. Lewis
- How's the weather in Denver on Saturday?

OVERDRIVE UPDATE FOR iPad

If you use Overdrive and have updated your iOS device(s) to 10.0.2, you now have to update Overdrive to v.3.5.7 to use the "enlarge font" feature to read your ebook. Here's how to do that. Have your library card number available.

IMPORTANT: Before you update Overdrive: to keep a copy of your "history," those books that you've already read, click on History, click on Select All, and

then click on the share icon and email the list to yourself. Otherwise, your Overdrive history will be gone.

To determine which version of Overdrive you're using, do this:

1. Click on the "hamburger" menu, the three small horizontal lines top left on the home page, or if you're reading your book when you tap the center of the screen; this brings down a side menu showing several choices.
2. Select "About," (See Figure 1) the bottom choice in the side menu that has appeared. There you'll see which version you have.

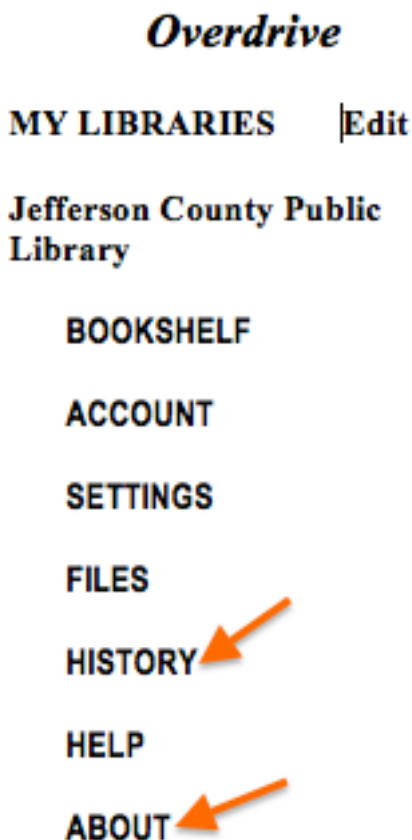

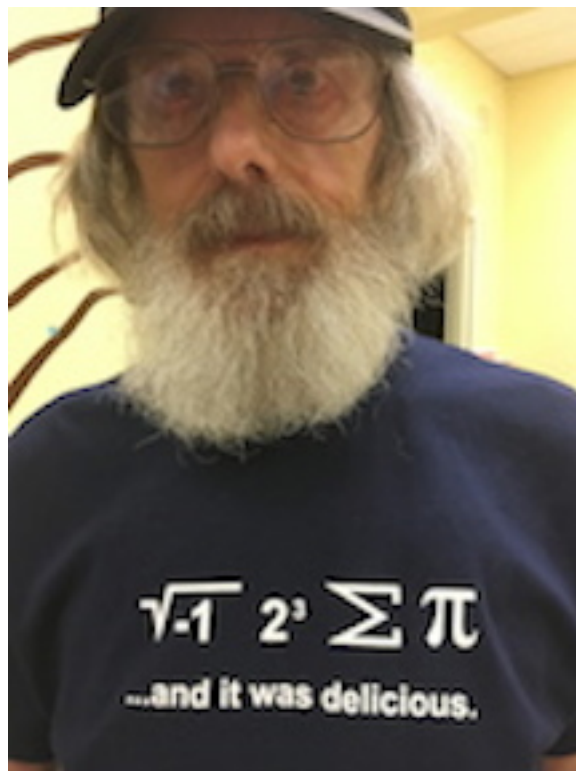
Now you need to delete the older Overdrive version and download the new one, v. 3.5.7.

1. Go to the desktop, hold down the Overdrive app until it wiggles and the "x" appears. Tap on the x and the app will be dumped.
2. Next, go to the App Store and download the new version of Overdrive v. 3.5.7.
