"LIKE-FARMING" ON FACEBOOK

Be careful what you "like" on Facebook. Note where it's coming from. If you don't know, don't click. If content promises you anything for liking or sharing, it's probably a scam.

"Like Farming" on Facebook is a story placed on a page anticipating from you a positive response (like) and then having you "share" the story. When enough likes and shares are registered through this Facebook story, the scammer can edit it and add something malicious. The like-farmer either removes the page's original content and replaces it with something else (usually malware or scam advertising); leaves the page as is and uses it as a platform for continued like-farming in order to spread malware, collect people's marketing information or engage in other harmful activities; or outright sells the highly liked site to cybercriminals in a black market web forum.

- 1. Go to jeffcolibrary.org and click on "Research" towards the top middle of the screen.
- 2. On the right hand side of the page, under "research Databases" click on A-Z List.
- 3. Then click on "L" and scroll down the Lynda.com.
- 4. This will take you to the Lynda.com website. Click on the blue "Create a profile" button and enter in your library card number and password and follow the set up instructions.



iOS UPDATE 10.3.1 FOR iPHONE AND iPAD AND iPOD TOUCH

If security is of importance to you on your mobile devices, you should update to 10.3.1 that was introduced in April 3, 2017. Updating from 10.3 brings a single security patch for a potential Wi-Fi exploit. However, *and this is significant*, upgrading from previous OS's such as iOS 10, iOS 10.2.1 will bring over 60 patches including a ransomware bug used by scammers to extort iOS users who viewed pornography on their device. The update delivers a new Find My AirPods feature that's located inside of the Find My iPhone application.

Requirements:

iPhone 5 and later iPad 4th generation and later iPod touch 6th generation and later

HOW TO REMOVE A YAHOO (OR OTHER) MAIL ACCOUNT FROM MAC

This will completely delete an email address and email account from the Mac, including all settings for the email account and associated emails from the Mail app in Mac OS X.

- 1. Pull down your **4** Apple Menu and choose "System Preferences"
- 2. Select "Internet Accounts"
- **3.** Select the email account you want to delete
- **4.** With the email account selected, click the [-] minus button at bottom or use the delete key
- 5. Confirm that you want to remove the email account as well as all of its associated emails and account settings from the Mac, including from the Mail applications
- 6. The account will disappear from the list and all associated emails and settings from the email address will also vanish. You can repeat with other email accounts as necessary

Remove an email account from your iOS device(s) as well as the associated data from the iOS device.

- 1. Go to Settings
- 2. Scroll down to Mail
- **3.** Tap on the Accounts
- **4.** Tap on the account you want to remove
- **5.** Confirm the email address/account is accurate
- **6.** Tap on "Delete Account" at bottom of screen
