RULES REGARDING FILES AND THEIR MOVEMENT – JUST A REMINDER FROM MAC-FORUMS.COM

Cmd + Drag = Moves the file Option + Drag = Copies the file Cmd + Option + Drag = Creates an Alias

If you just Drag a file, the result tends to depend on the destination: normally to EHD (external hard drive) it copies; to Dropbox it should copy; to another place on your Mac, it usually moves.

HOW TO RENAME BATCH FILES

Alexander Fox of Apple Gazette shows methods to rename batch files. Photographers will appreciate this when moving groups of photos. Method 1 uses macOS's Finder's Batch Rename Tool—a built-in tool for renaming a group of files. Method 2 called "Better Rename" is a more powerful renaming utility that you can purchase from the Mac App Store. Better Rename has many options including find and replace text, add text and rename based on regular expressions. View the complete article on the website which shows the step-by-step process.

FIND EMAILS MORE EASILY IN iOS 10 AND MACOS SIERRA USING FILTERS




Figure 1 -- iPhone email Filtered by Unread




Figure 2 -- iPhone email. Click to add/subtract filter

You can search with the search bar at the top of the email as in previous iOS. New in iOS 10 is a filter that applies only to the mailbox you're viewing. In your mail Inbox, look at bottom of the screen and see "Updated Just Now." If you tap the circle icon to the left, it will change to blue and tell you "Filtered by: Unread" or whatever filter you have selected (see Figure 1). To make/change your filter selection, tap on "Filtered by" and a new screen will come up and you can change filters (see Figure 2). Mail remembers the filters you've chosen for individual mailboxes.

On your iOS devices mail, click on the filter at bottom of the screen to change the filter.




Figure 3 -- Mac email sort




Figure 4 -- Mac email filtered

On your Mac email, click on your "sort by" choices (Figure 3 -- Mac email sort), and set your filters (Figure 4 – Mac email filtered).

He comments that despite claims by audiologists that this test couldn't be done online, he did it and has put this free test online.

There are three steps to follow and you will need headphones.

- 1. Calibrate *your* sound levels
- 2. Listen to individual test files
- 3. Review your audiogram
