MALWARE INFECTION OF HANDBRAKE CONVERSION APP

A popular video conversion app for Mac has suffered a malware infection on one of its mirror servers. If you downloaded Hand-Brake between 10:30 a.m. EDT on May 2, 2017 and 7:00 p.m. EDT on May 6, 2017, you should follow these instructions to check your Mac for a new variant of the malware OSX.PROTON. Yes, HandBrake was compromised by malware. Go to the MacObserver website below to determine if you have HandBrake and how to remove it if you do.

FREE APPS INCLUDING iWORK

In April 2017, Apple made several of its apps entirely free. Previously, Pages, Numbers, Keynote, GarageBand, and iMovie were included free with the purchase of a new device, but adding them to older hardware required you to pay up. Now you don't need to spend a cent, as long as your devices are running a recent OS. At last, you can replace your eight-year-old iWork '09 suite with versions that work better between macOS and iOS. With these apps, it's easy to craft beautiful documents, smart spreadsheets, and powerful presentations.

On a Mac, you'll need macOS 10.12 to run Pages, Numbers, or Keynote, but iMovie needs only OS X 10.11.2, and GarageBand works on OS X 10.10. On an iPhone or iPad, Pages, Numbers, Keynote, and GarageBand all need iOS 10, but you can run iMovie on iOS 9.3. Head to the App Store (<u>iOS</u>, <u>Mac</u>) to get your free apps.

BATTERY LIFE AND CHARGING YOUR MACBOOK

Gary Rosenzweig of MacMost has an article and a video that show MacBook owners what's going on with their battery cycles and whether you should keep your MacBook plugged in all the time. Should you turn your MacBook off when you are done using it or just close the lid? Different MacBook models and ages are shown on an Apple page he references so you can determine which battery information is special for your MacBook. At some point in time, an older, well-used battery will need to be replaced, so the reference below can be a guide. Below the video are comments from readers (always useful, I find).

Use Sleep Mode or Shut Down after Using your Macs?

For all your Macs, Gary also has a 2009 video on whether you should use "shut down" or "sleep" mode when you're done for the day or when you're traveling. http://macmost.com/shut-down-orsleep.html. He suggests that if you're questioning why anyone would use sleep mode rather than shutting down (to save energy, for instance), he suggests that you give sleep mode a try for a few weeks and see if you don't prefer it—he gives some good examples why sleep mode is really a lot more efficient, both for your mental processes (you don't have to reboot, remember where your open apps and files are) and for your computers. Sleep mode actually uses very little energy while a reboot uses more energy. By the way, this guideline does not apply to a PC. They need to be shut down rather than put to sleep.

LUMINAR – IMAGE EDITING "A PRO APP IN CONSUMER DISGUISE" Flexible, intuitive and simple

Macphun introduces Luminar as a new "flagship" photo editing app that it compares to Photoshop and Lightroom without the famously-steep learning curve in Photoshop. Its massive number of slider-based tools is designed for all skill levels. Additionally, it can launch as a standalone app or as a plugin to Photoshop, Lightroom, Aperture, or as an Apple Photos extension with an interface that is identical for all apps. What it doesn't have is an "asset management system," so you must use it in conjunction with existing photo libraries.
