Easy Fixes for Problems

MacLife, September 2014, has an article on easy fixes for problems with your Mac. They are:

1. Turn it off and on.
2. Try the Help menu.
3. Reset the SMC.
4. Reset the NVRAM.
5. Start in Safe Mode.
6. Reset your password.
7. Fire up Disk Utility.
8. Disconnect peripherals.

Each of these has a few paragraphs of info to explain precisely what to do.

Apple has info on their Web site about resetting the SMC and resetting the NVRAM, which you should check out before resetting them.

OS X Yosemite

The new operating system will be released in the fall. It is named for the national park.

Features:

- new typography
- new look for the dock
- new look for icons
- translucent title bars
- Notification Center, with Today view just like on iOS 7
- brighter Spotlight, providing easy access to files, Bing search results, Wikipedia, your apps, maps, Yelp reviews, and other content
- improved Mail app, including a feature called Mail Drop (which prevents e-mail attachments from being bounced) and Markup (which enables you to scribble on and annotate images you send in Messages)
- speedier Safari
- iCloud Drive (which works in much the same way as Dropbox)
- improved Airdrop (The sharing actually works!)
- no Siri

iOS 8

Features:

- interactive notifications (enables you to process notifications without exiting the app you're in)
- improved Spotlight
- improved Messaging
- smarter Siri
- Family Sharing (enables up to six accounts to be linked together under the same credit card, syncs Calendar to include everyone's schedule)
- iCloud photo library (enabling iOS and Mac owners to put an entire photo collection into the cloud)
- app called Health (enabling third-party devices to share health data with your iOS device)
- iCloud Drive
- predictive typing
- support of third-party keyboards
- more efficient Mail
- smarter home apps

Suggestions to get better search results:

1. Don't ask questions.
2. Type what you're looking for and then *site:* and then the domain name. You will get results just from that site.
3. Use a tilde in front of the search word to find related words.
4. Put a phrase in double quotes to find the exact phrase.
5. Put a hyphen in front of any word you want excluded from your search. If you want to exclude a phrase, put a hyphen and then put the phrase in double quotes.

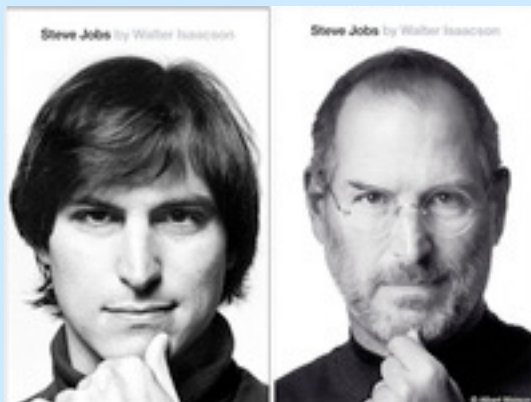
