SCREENIUM 1.1

(Note: **Screenium** will be the subject of DAPI August 2009 Mac SIG meeting)

While taking a "One to One" course at a local Apple store, DAPI member Kathy Cusack was concerned about remembering everything she was being taught. She was writing frantically to document the new information when another instructor suggested Screenium, an application that would record the instructor's voice as well as everything that was being demonstrated on screen. With Screenium, Kathy can return to her private tutoring lesson on her computer to reinforce her lessons. Below is the description of this program. Note the Demo Video available online.

Quickly make live videos of your Mac's screen... capture everything that's happening there, including mouse pointer, selections and movements - in real-time! Since the very first release of Screenium, we support virtually any resolution your Mac is capable of: you can capture just small excerpts of your screen or even Full HD video and even higher resolutions.

Describe what you are doing on-screen, with on-the-fly voice recordings and iSight Picture-in-Picture. Simply use the built-in microphone or iSight. Any external audio input device and QuickTime-compatible webcam are also fully supported. For the more creative tutorials, you can capture Movie-in-Movie. Screenium records your screen just like it is - including ongoing video playback, in multiple windows.

ABOUT FIND ANY FILE, **VERSION 1.2.1** ★★★★

Find Any File - 1.2.1 is a highlyrated five-star free application that searches your local disks for file properties such as name, dates, size, type or creator with unique features:

- Uses new hierarchical view of found items making it easier to browse 100s of items
- Can run as root user, finding any file on your disk, even those hidden from normal users

Contrary to Spotlight, it does not use a database but instead uses the file system driver's fast search operations, where available. This lets you search for file properties such as name, dates, size, etc., but not for file content (use Spotlight for that).

Find Any File can find files that Spotlight doesn't, e.g., those inside bundles and packages and in inside folders that are usually excluded from Spotlight search.

Finally, it is fast. Not always as fast as Spotlight, but faster than other, similar file search tools you might find for the Mac.

FORWARDING MULTIPLE EMAILS

If you have a need to forward more than one email message in Mail, it's amazingly simple. Just select all of the messages you'd like to forward—using the Shift (for multiple contiguous messages) and/or Command (for single messages) keys as necessary to make your selection. Then select Message -> Forward (or press Shift-Command-F). A new message window will appear with the contents of every selected message, including their basic headers, and the words 'Begin forwarded message' above each one.

Fill in the recipient and subject, click Send, and you're done. (You can also conserve paper when printing multiple messages, if you're into the printed word.)

KLIX RECOVERS DELETED PHOTOS AND MOVIES

Klix 1.0.2 recovers deleted photos and movies from memory cards. Works with OS 10.2 – 10.5. If you have deleted photos, reformatted the disk and then discovered to your horror that you erred, this is the program for you. This JoeSoft product has a 5-mouse rating—the best there is. The software works with most USB or FireWire cameras except xD memory cards after they've

been formatted in an Olympus or Fuji camera.
