Ironically, the Denver Broncos are now <u>using iPads</u> to replace their paper playbooks. Only the Baltimore Ravens and the Tampa Bay Buccaneers also use iPads instead of traditional paper playbooks, so for the upcoming season we can see if these three teams seem to be more efficient in winning games.

The Broncos figure the savings from not having to print tens of thousands of playbook pages each season will offset the cost of purchasing 120 iPads with Verizon Wireless 4G access. To create their digital playbook, The Denver Broncos partnered with Parker-based technology start-up PlayerLync.

The PlayerLync app allows players and coaches to write notes and highlight plays using the iPad's touchscreen. "It used to require players to come in, meet as a group, hand off pieces of paper, 'Here's your new play,'

" said Bob Paulsen, PlayerLync chief executive. "Now it's all going to be automatically downloaded."

In the past, if a team lost their paper playbook, their information could fall in the wrong hands. If someone loses an iPad, the team can remotely wipe the iPad clean. If the iPad's network connection gets disabled, the app includes a "time bomb" feature that will automatically delete the playbook information after a fixed period of time.

With the iPad being lighter, easier to update, and difficult to steal its information, the iPad offers huge benefits over printed copies. Paper is simply too expensive and inflexible and this trend will only continue. The iPad and digital distribution of information is the future. The Denver Broncos know this. Now we just have to see how long it takes for the rest of the NFL and the world to catch up.

USING FIREFOX, UNABLE TO OPEN PDFS By Joyce Etherton

After publishing the April 2012 issue of *The Seed*, I went to our DAPi website to check it out as I always do. When I clicked on the April newsletter, I got a blank page instead of the PDF I usually get. My first thought was that maybe John Nelson made a mistake and didn't make my PDF copy of *The Seed* web compatible as he always has done. Then I thought maybe I had done something wrong. But, I couldn't open any of the previous newsletters either, which I knew were properly set up, so then I decided to Google my problem: "Can't open PDF using Firefox Browser." I found several forums discussing exactly this problem, and after making the proper changes to my Firefox browser preferences, I was able to open the website PDF just as before. (Please note that the Safari browser DID work and required no changes.) The following is from the web:

Q. Firefox 11.0 Installed Acrobat plugin 10.1.3 today doesn't work (ok in Safari) Installed extension PDF viewer 0.2.537 can now view PDF in firefox

A. If you want to use Adobe Acrobat, you can just change the preference that was messed up:

Go into Firefox >
Preferences > Applications
and look for "PDF file"

Next to that, **select "use Adobe Acrobat"** rather than

Adobe Acrobat NPAPI 10.1.3

Adobe's NPAPI plugin doesn't work in 64-bit Firefox ... there's probably a bug where the Adobe Reader update is setting that preference.
