With [Wi-Fi Finder for iPhone and iPad](#), you can instantly find free as well as paid wi-fi spots in 144 countries worldwide whether you are online or offline. JiWire's Global FREE Wi-Fi app uses your iPhone's GPS and network triangulation capabilities to locate free Wi-Fi Internet access.

Features:

- ★ Over 145,000 Free locations worldwide
- ★ "Near me" search based on your current location
- ★ Search specific geographic regions
- ★ Filter by location type (Cafe, Library, etc.)
- ★ Phone numbers and address info
- ★ Bookmark your favorite locations

New locations are added on a daily basis, so you always have

the latest hotspot data at your fingertips.

Caveat from a user: "This app has plenty of bugs, but is still useful. Be sure to close out of the app and reset it after every search or it will say there is nothing near you. Be sure to download and index the database before you try to use it, too."

## MANUALLY CONFIGURE FORMER .MAC EMAIL ADDRESSES ON MACBOOK PRO TO WORK ON ICLOUD ACCOUNT

## WHAT NEXT? A WEARABLE COMPUTER

Apple has just been awarded a patent for eyeglasses that would display apps, video, images and overlay information on the world around you in real time. The eyeglasses would display the images in front of both the user's eyes using LCD projectors located on both sides of the eyeglasses from a connected device such as a smartphone or television. The aspect ratio of 16:9 is similar to the next iPhone ratio dimension.

Although this patent was filed in 2006, the US Patent and Trademark Office has just published it which may indicate Apple's concern that Google Glass may infringe on the patent. Speculation about the popularity of these glasses suggests it may not be all that popular because people who don't wear glasses may not be that interested, and it could become as "uncool" as the Bluetooth earpiece has become.

**FROM COMPUTEREDGE ONLINE**

Barry Fass-Holmes's article "Macintosh OS X Lion Tips v.2" in the June 1, 2012 gives ten of Lion's lesser-known new features, two of which are shown below.

**2. Older Macs Need Not Apply**

Lion requires a [modern Macintosh](#), namely one with Intel's Core 2 Duo, Core i3, Core i5, Core i7, or Xeon CPU. Any model Mac with an Intel Core Duo or Solo CPU, or one with a PowerPC CPU is stuck at an older version of OS X.
