What is Dropbox? Dropbox is a way to share files, small or large with yourself (on another computer or device) or with others. No more hauling around flash drives to bring your files with you, simply drop them in a folder on your computer and they are instantly available on your iPad, another computer, or from the Dropbox website.

ICONS IN TOOLBAR

Looks like Mavericks 10.9 has changed the behavior for adding application/document shortcuts to the Finder toolbar.

Where before you could simply drag any icon up to the Finder toolbar and hold it there for a second to add it, you now need to first hold down Option+Command and then start dragging the desired icon to the toolbar.

You can still remove the icons the same way as before: holding down Command, dragging the icon away from the toolbar and then releasing.



APPLE BEGINS USING iBEACONS AT ALL ITS 254 US RETAIL STORES



Apple on Friday (12/06/2013) will launch its iBeacon wireless short-range technology at all 254 retail stores the company owns across the U.S., helping customers to shop for new items, or pick up an order they've already placed.

In order to test iBeacons at an Apple retail location, users must have the official Apple Store app installed, and they must have Bluetooth enabled. Users must also allow the app to access their iPhone's location data, and for the app to send them push notifications. Upon entering a store, the app will switch to an "in-store mode."
