In addition to many other internet support websites, Apple has a comprehensive online help from both Apple and from "The Apple Support Community." Look to this community to see whether someone else has your

problem and whether there is a solution. You may not need to go any farther than this. If this fails, at the bottom is a link to "Contact Apple Support" where you will again select your device, your problems, etc., and then you can click on Connect by phone, chat, email, and more.

First, you should begin at the beginning (was it Socrates or Plato that said that?). https://support.apple.com/:

BEFORE YOU SELL, TRADE-IN OR GIVE AWAY YOUR IOS DEVICES https://support.apple.com/en-us/HT201351

Apple Support has comprehensive instructions on how you should remove personal data from your iOS devices when you get rid of them. It's important that you do the step-by-step instructions so you can retain data somewhere that you will need for your new devices.

If you no longer have your device that's still loaded with your data, follow the step-by-step instructions for this situation. Included is what to do if you're changing to a non-Apple device, removing credit or debit cards if you use Apple Pay.

A concern you should be aware of is that you can permanently damage you device, called "bricking," by inadvertently tapping something that you shouldn't. Bricking is a metaphor meaning the device is now "as useful as a brick." Some types of bricking are fixable, others are not. Following Apple's instructions should help you avoid this problem.

As an incentive to upgrade to the new iPhone XR, iPhone XS, Apple has a limited-time offer of credit for eligible devices. This is considered a limited-time offer and the devices must meet their criteria as "eligible." However, Apple will recycle your ineligible devices "no matter the model or

condition" so Apple can "turn it into something good for your and good for the planet."



BURP YOUR IPAD MINI?

Before you resort to the burp method, follow these guidelines to restart your iPad Mini if it won't come on:

- Press and hold the Sleep/Wake button and the Home button until Apple logo appears (2-20 seconds)
- Release buttons and all should be ready to go in a few seconds.

or

Perform System Update

- Open iTunes on your computer with latest version of iTunes
- Insert charging cable in the iPad but not the computer
- Hold Home button down and at same time insert charging cable into your computer
- Keep holding Home button until "Connect to iTunes screen" appears
- Repeat these steps if iTunes screen doesn't appear after 30 seconds
- Release Home button when screen showing Lightning cable, arrow and red iTunes appears. Chose option to Update (not restore)

Make sure your iPad mini is charged. If battery icon shows red, not green, plug it in and wait until it turns green so it will have enough battery strength to continue. If screen is black after turning it on, the iPad mini may not have enough power to reveal battery status. If icon not visible, plug in for

several hours for battery to recover. Make sure you're using at least a 5W USB Power Adapter pugged into the wall. Also, battery stress can occur when in cold or hot temperatures. Get it back to room temperature and it may start without any fuss and muss.



Now that you've taken all the standard steps to restart your iPad and it still isn't on, try

this (remember, everything in moderation):

- Make sure iPad is off.
- Cover iPad mini front and back securely with a towel, and pat the back of the iPad as though you are burping a baby. Continue for one minute and then try turning it on. This may realign loose cables (contacts) that aren't making a connection.

Samsung has been caught tweeting from an iPhone ... again.



- **Safari**, the one that comes with your iOS device.
- **Chrome**, the browser provided by Google.
- **Firefox**, a browser with robust search options from Mozilla.

- **Dolphin**, a browser for "touch-based" gestures.
