**APPLE VIRTUAL EVENT MARCH 8, 2022**

This March 8 event will be the first event of the year and the company is expected to announce the iPhone SE 3, iPad Air 5 and a new Mac Mini according to Rounak Jain from the Business Insider dated February 7, 2022.

According to MacRumors, another Apple support site, Apple will launch its first MacBook Pro featuring a second-generation M2 Apple silicon processor. DigiTimes reports (February 8, 2022) that "Apple's supply chain partners kept production lines running during the Lunar New Year holiday (January 31 to February 6, 2022 is the public holiday) for the new MacBook Pro," so the release of a new MacBook Pro is likely for early March 2022.

Battery Health reporting was added to Macs with the macOS 10.5.5 Catalina update, so to check your battery health you must be running 10.5.5 or newer to have this feature.

For starters, to begin the Battery health check for your MacBook Pro, MacBook Air, MacBook.

- Must be using 10.5.5 Catalina or newer.
- Click Apple Menu top left
- Choose System Preferences from dropdown menu
- Click on battery (shown below) and continue following instructions after you click on the battery shown below.

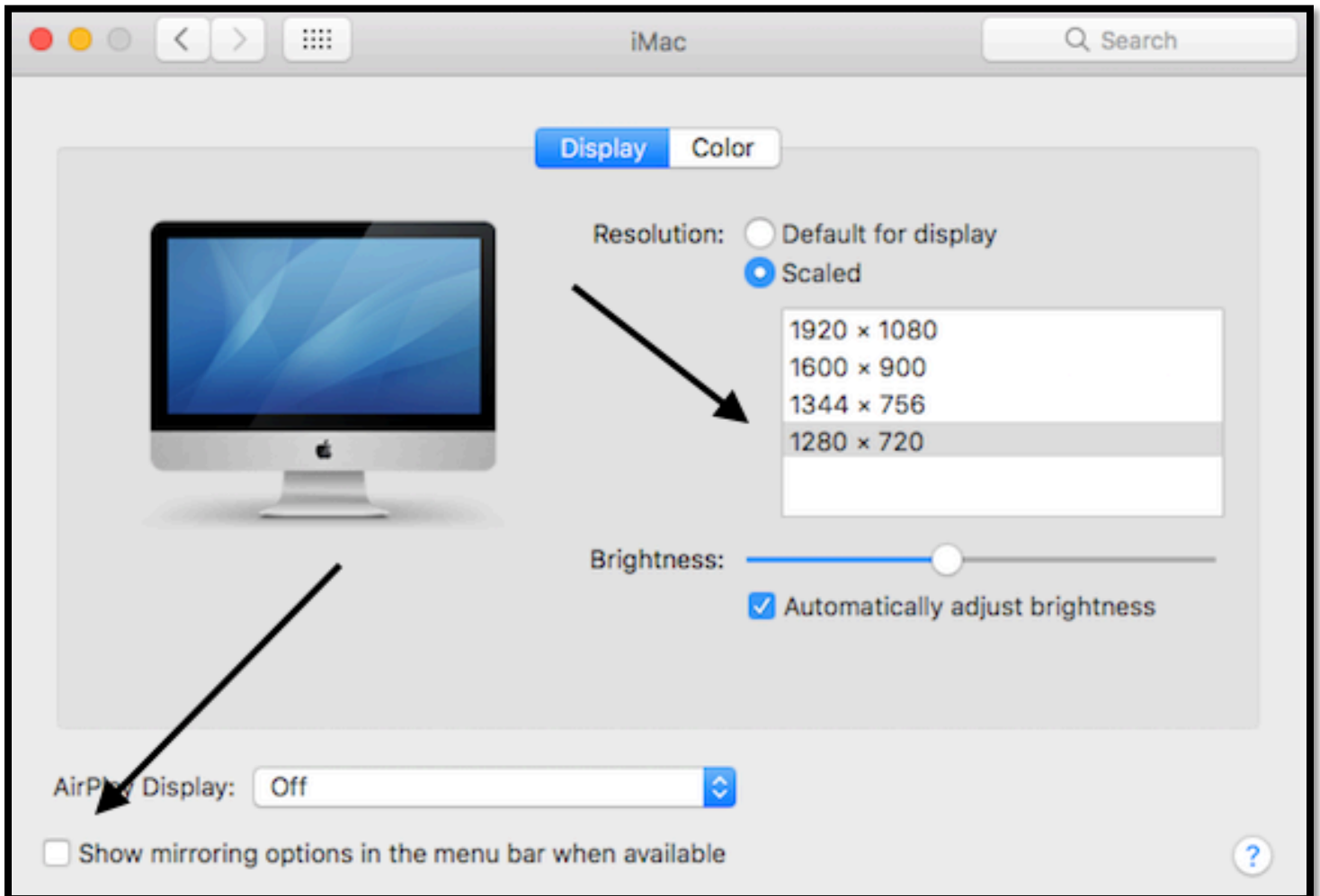


## HOW TO ENLARGE COMPUTER SCREEN DISPLAY GOOD FOR OLDER EYES

*Suggested by DAPi Member Herman Pflueger*

You can get larger print size and viewing by adjusting the Display settings. Go to the  and System Preferences. Select "Displays" and when you get there, you can select "Scaled" and take the lesser number, e.g., 1280 x 720, to make the print larger. You must unclick "Show mirroring options in menu bar when available" for this to work.

Similar changes can be made on your other Apple devices by going to Settings, and choose Display and Brightness.
